LITIGATION

Have you ever received a subpoena or deposition notice unexpectedly and were unsure of your next steps? This happened to five of our clients in December. These clients sought the help of Paul Prados to challenge the subpoenas for documents, and to create restrictions for the depositions

At a hearing in January, attorney Prados argued for and obtained an order quashing (canceling) the subpoenas for documents and proscribing clear rules for any depositions. Although the clients will likely be subject to further subpoenas as the case progresses, their rights have been protected and they have no duties for now. Working with seasoned litigators is often necessary even when parties have not been sued. If you receive a subpoena remember to consult with counsel before responding.



XLP SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDS CONTRACTOR PROPOSED FOR FEDERAL DEBARMENT

Johns, and the XLP Government Contracts team successfully defended a client and their Government Contracting firm from a proposed debarment by a U.S. Military Contracting Agency based on alleged misconduct pursuant to Section 9.406 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR). To that end, Cody and Milt opposed the proposed debarment, the allegations, and accurately represented the Client's position during a contract procurement. As such, the U.S. Military Contracting Agency terminated the proposed debarment in finding that the client and its Government Contracting Firm were no longer a threat.
